### Personal Information Under CCPA's Provisions on Privacy Rights

- **Biometric data**
  - Biological or behavioral characteristics
  - DNA
  - Iris image or retina

  - Race

  - Marital status
  - Sex
  - Age
  - Sexual orientation
- **Geolocation data**
- **Health insurance data**
- **Internet or network activity information (cookie data)**
  - Browsing history
  - Search history
  - Information about a consumer's interaction with a website or application
  - Advertisement interaction
- **Medical information**
- **Personal information**
  - Real name
  - Alias
  - Postal address
  - Telephone number
  - Unique personal identifier
  - Online identifier
  - IP address
  - Email address
  - Account name
  - Social security number

Inferences drawn from any of the information identified above that could be used to create a profile about a consumer's preferences, characteristics, psychological trends, predispositions, behavior, attitudes, intelligence, and aptitudes.

## APPENDIX B

### Personal Information Under CCPA's Security Requirements

- (A) An individual's first name or first initial and his or her last name **in combination with any one or more of the following data elements**:
- (i) Social security number;
  - (ii) Driver's license number or California identification card number; tax identification number; passport number; military identification number; or other unique identification number issued on a government document commonly used to verify the identify of a specific individual;
  - (iii) Account number, credit or debit card number, **in combination with** any required security code, access code, or password that would permit access to an individual's financial account;
  - (iv) Medical information;
  - (v) Health insurance information;
  - (vi) Unique biometric data generated from measurements or technical analysis of human body characteristics, such as a fingerprint, retina, or iris image, used to authenticate a specific individual. Unique biometric data does not include a physical or digital photograph, unless used or stored for facial recognition purposes.
- (B) A username or email address **in combination with** a password or security question and answer that would permit access to an online account.
